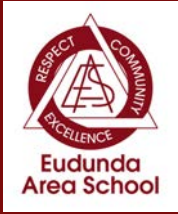

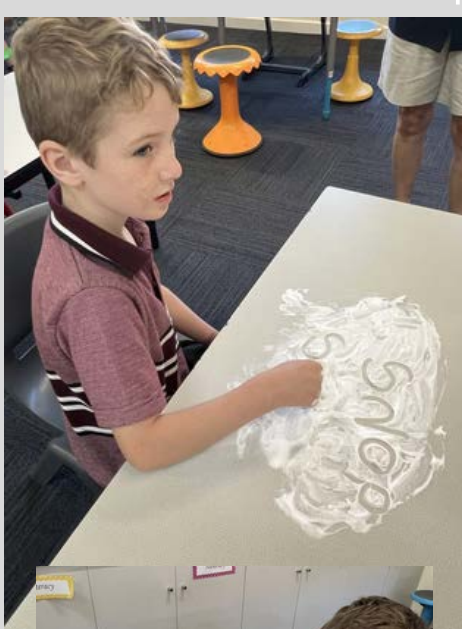
Our Student leadership group enjoyed a day at Woodhouse Activity Centre on Monday. Students worked together doing a team building session followed by completing Challenge Hill.
