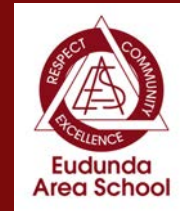

Throughout Semester One, Eudunda Area School has embraced learning opportunities that support students understanding of their options post school. These have included the Hospitality/Barista Course for senior students, the STEM immersion experience, and Tonsley Innovation District for Year 9 students, University workshops for Years 10, 11 and 12 and the incursion activity run by the MTA (Motor Trades Association) for Year 10 students and the Senior Pedal Prix team in week.



Many more activities are planned for Semester Two, to keep students informed and 'thinking' about their future pathways and how this impacts subject choices as they transition into Senior secondary School. Mr Neville drives our Career Education Program through the Personal Learning Plan at Stage 1 and Positive Education lessons for Junior Secondary/Upper Primary students. All Year 10 students will be involved in work experience in Week 3 of Term 3. Not only does this give them the opportunity to develop their employability skills, it also helps them cement decisions about their future study/employment direction.
